Maximum words: 250; Abstract font: Times New Roman/Calibri; Font size 12; in Word format

Places of Interest

Golghar- located to the west of the Gandhi Maidan is one of the famous landmarks of Patna.



Takht Har Mandir Sahib - is one of the prominent places in Patna of Sikh religion



Shaheed Smarak- exhibits life-size statue of seven young men who sacrificed their lives in the **Quit India Movement** (August 1942)

Patna Museum -This Museum was constructed by the British to conserve and display the historical artifacts found in the vicinity of the state capital of Bihar.



Buddha Memorial Park- This park was inaugurated by the Tibetan spiritual leader, Dalai Lama, on 27 May 2010 who planted two saplings, one was brought from Bodh Gaya and the other from Anuradhapura in Sri Lanka.



Patna Marine Drive, also known as Loknayak Ganga Path, is a 20.5-kilometre-long four-lane expressway along the banks of the River Ganges in Patna.



Bihar Museum has embellished a multitude of artifacts and is a hub of historical knowledge.

AROUND PATNA

56 Kms from Patna by Road- VAISHALI *World's First Republic*-Vaishali is where Buddha preached his last sermon before his death. Vishwa Shanti Stupa (**World Peace Pagoda**) is a major monument here. **King Ashoka** erected his famous Ashoka pillar in Vaishali.



90 Kms from Patna by Road - NALANDA-*One of the oldest living cities - A UNESCO world heritage site today*, It is widely recognised as one of the ancient world's great universities and an important Buddhist centre of academic excellence.



110 Kms from Patna by Road.

RAJGIR-*Court of Magadha Empire*- **Ropeway** here is said to be the oldest in the country which runs at the top of Ratnagiri Hills.

135 Kms from Patna by Road.

BODHGAYA-*The place where Gautama Buddha got Enlightenment. For Buddhists, Bodh Gaya is the most important of the main four pilgrimage sites, the other three being Kushinagar, Lumbini, and Sarnath.*
